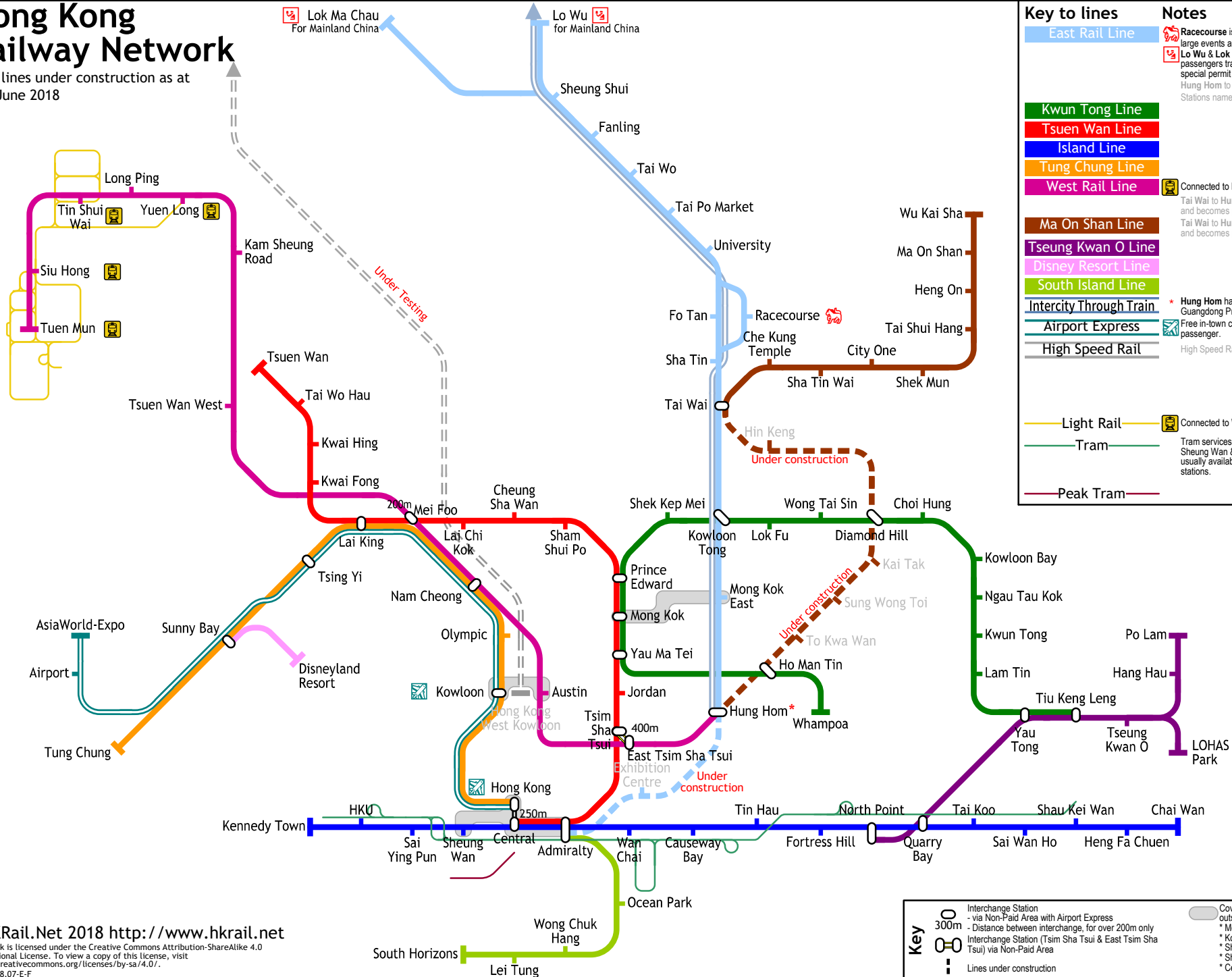


Hong Kong Railway Network

Notes

- Racecourse is only open during race days or when large events are held at Sha Tin Racecourse.
- Lo Wu & Lok Ma Chau are only available to passengers travelling to mainland China or with special permit only.
- Hung Hom to Admiralty will open in 2021. Stations name is tentative.
- Connected to Light Rail
- Tai Wai to Hung Hom section will open in 2019 and becomes part of the Tuen Ma Line.
- Tai Wai to Hung Hom section will open in 2019 and becomes part of the Tuen Ma Line.
- * Hung Hom has intercity train services connecting Guangdong Province, Shanghai, and Beijing.
- Free in-town check-in services available to passenger.
- High Speed Rail will open in late 2018.
- Connected to West Rail Line.
- Tram services overlap with Island Line between Sheung Wan & Shau Kei Wan. Tram stations are usually available within 300m from Island Line's stations.
