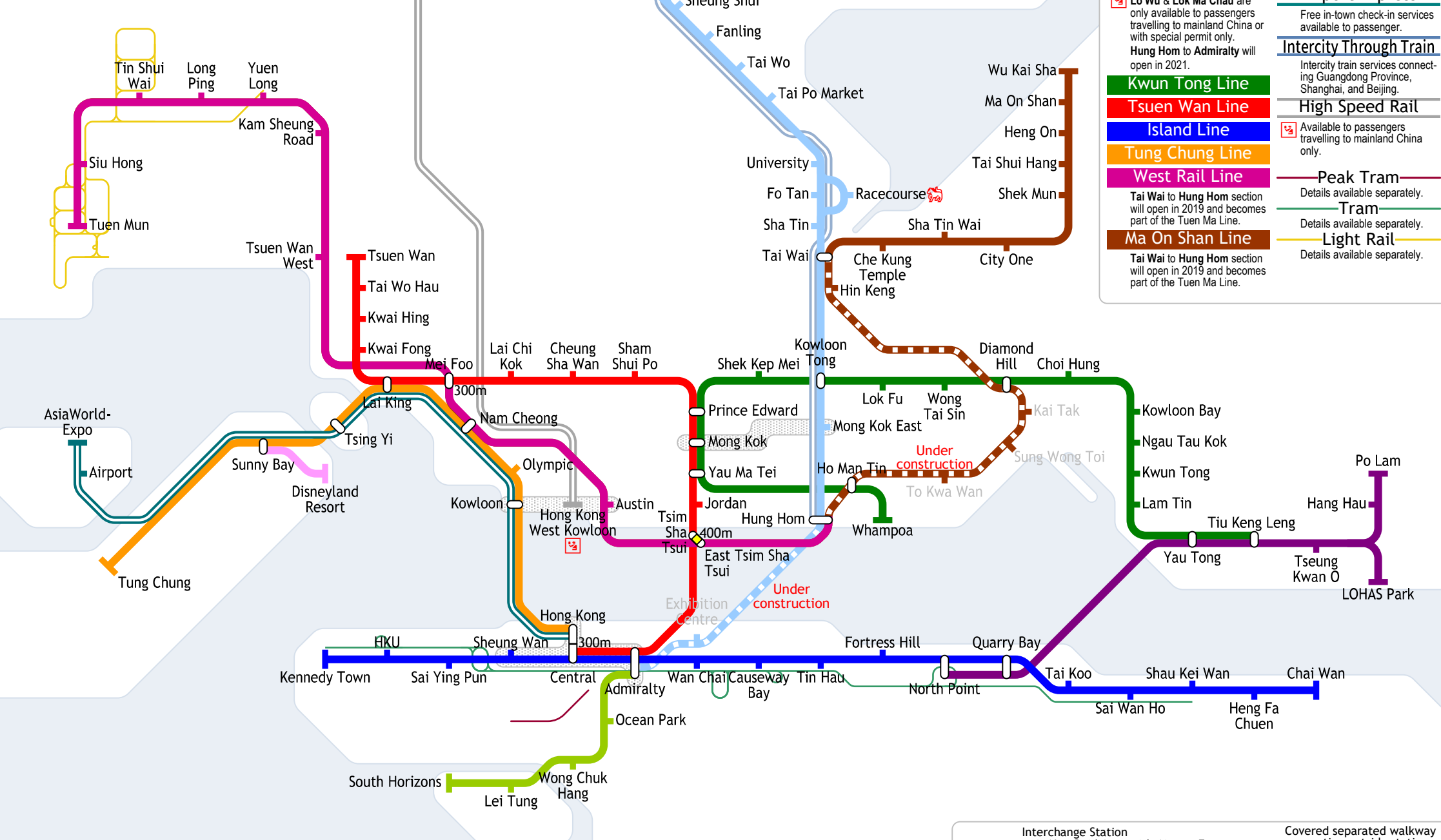


Hong Kong Railway Network
